Themes ranged from Dr Who to an on-line adventure series and a quiz about London.

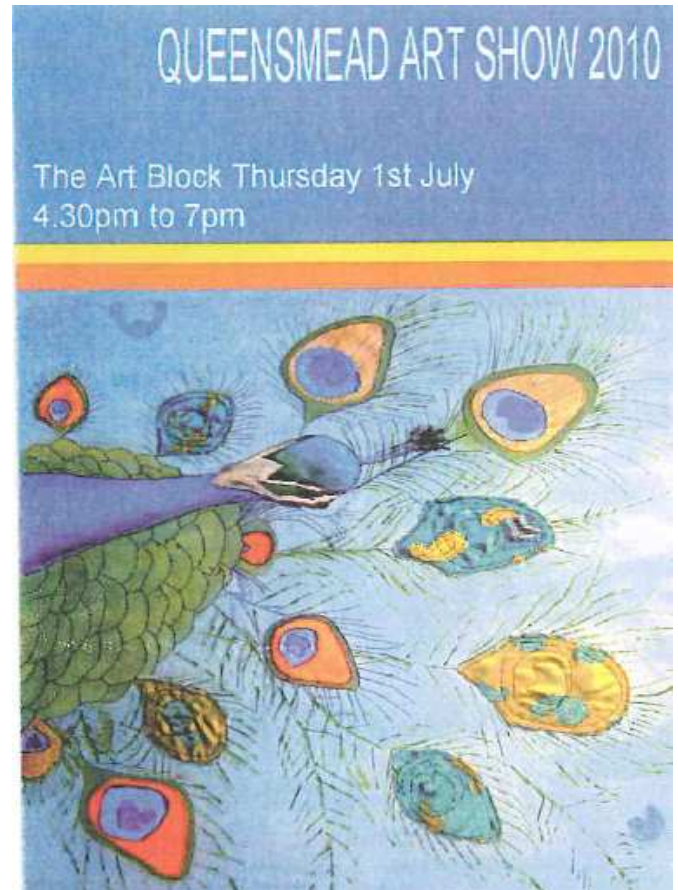
Mr Peters was impressed at the students enthusiasm and ability and enjoyed it almost as much as they did.
